



CLASSES

One Fish, Two Fish, a-b-c Fish (3 YRS – 6 yrs)

Dive into the A-B-C's and 1-2-3's with the creatures at the Downtown Aquarium! Explore letters and numbers by naming and counting aquatic creatures, from Angelfish to Zebra Sharks.

Habitat Highlights (7 yrs – 9 yrs)

Join us as we hike up to the Alpine tundra, trek through the rainforest and then dive into the deep sea. Uncover the secret adaptations that animals in each of these habitats have to survive in their special habitats.

Coral communities (7 yrs – 9 yrs)

A coral reef is a colorful neighborhood home to many different animals. Find out if coral is an animal, plant, or mineral! Learn with us what it takes to be a coral and why so many creatures live together in one place.

Boneless Bodies (3 yrs – 6 yrs)

Some animals have no bones! Join us as we learn about jiggling jellies, spiny lobsters and crawly crabs. While playing a fun movement game, students will discover more about how some boneless animals adapt to their watery world.

Sensational sharks (3 yrs - 13 yrs)

Sharks are sensational! Students will learn about how sharks use senses like sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch to help them survive in the ocean. This class is intended for families with students of multiple ages to learn together, so all children in the classroom must be registered and willing to participate!

Invertebrate investigations (10 yrs -13 yrs)

Did you know that invertebrates account for 97% of the animal species on earth? Take a close look at some of these amazing creatures in our hands-on lab, designed to introduce students to the practice and complexity of classification.

SQUID: Inside and out (10 yrs+)

Squid are equipped with amazing physical and behavioral adaptations. In this dissection class, students will learn about the unique characteristics of this clever invertebrate by looking both inside and out. Hands-on participation required!


Aquarium: The Inside Story (10+ yrs) (14+ Yrs)


